Project Overview

The Hyatt House project was about time and aesthetics. Southern Wall Systems worked closely with the design team to develop the look for the new hotel construction in Nashville, Tennessee, and fabricated and installed StoPanel Classic ci panels with a StoColor® Lotusan® finish on an accelerated timeline, resulting in a stunning hotel and a very pleased client.

Job Requirements

The design challenges of the Hyatt House went beyond the typical “fulfilling the architect’s vision” or “matching a historic finish.” In this project, the client had only a general notion about the desired facade for the project but had not decided on anything very specific, leaving it up to Southern Wall Systems to develop aesthetic ideas. But, because the job was running 4 months behind schedule, they couldn’t spend too much time in the design studio developing their ideas.

Smart Solution

Southern Wall Systems’ design team took the client’s general ideas about the facade and developed a full design featuring multiple textures and colors with the added benefit of having a durable, self-cleaning Lotusan finish. Their solution was met by the client’s enthusiastic approval, but the design was only the first step. The project was still four months behind schedule. By fabricating the StoPanel Classic ci panels offsite at their facility in advance of installation and quickly and efficiently installing them onsite, they made up a total of five months, actually putting the job a full month ahead of schedule. Not surprisingly, the client was, once again very pleased.
